This offer terms (this **Offer Terms**) must be read in conjunction with, the base prospectus dated 19 September 2019 (the **Base Prospectus**) as so supplemented and Final Terms for respective Series, prepared by IDB Trust Services Limited (in its capacity as issuer and trustee, the **Trustee**) and The Islamic Development Bank (the **IsDB**) with respect to the Trustee's U.S.\$25,000,000,000 trust certificate issuance programme (the **Programme**).

Trust Certificates are “Exempt Securities” for the purposes of section 1.2.2(1)(a) of AIFC Market Rules NO.FR0003 of 2017 (the **MAR Rules**) and shall be offered to Accredited Investors (as defined in section 1.1.2(6) of MAR Rules). Accordingly, the Issuer is exempt from a requirement to produce a Prospectus and the Base Prospectus has not been approved by Astana International Exchange for the purposes of MAR Rules. The application has been made to the Astana International Exchange (**AIX**) for the Trust Certificates (other than Exempt Certificates) to be admitted to the Official List maintained by AIX and to be admitted to trading on AIX. An application may be made for any Series to be admitted to trading on AIX.

Each of the Trustee and the IsDB accepts responsibility for the information contained in this Offer Terms and declares that the information contained in this Offer Terms is, to the best of their knowledge, complete, accurate and not misleading.

AIX, its directors, officers or employees, do not accept responsibility for the content of the information included in these Offer Terms, including the accuracy or completeness of such information. Nor has AIX, its directors, officers or employees, assessed the suitability of the securities to which the Offer Terms relates for any particular investor or type of investor.

The terms used herein shall be deemed to be defined as such and set forth in the Base Prospectus and any decision to invest into Trust Certificates should be based on a consideration of the Base Prospectus as a whole by any investor.

Full information on the Issuer, the IsDB and the offer of the Trust Certificates described herein is only available on the basis of the combination of this Offer Terms, Final Terms for respective Series and the Base Prospectus as supplemented. Transfers within Euroclear or Clearstream, Luxembourg, AIX Central Securities Depository will be in accordance with the usual rules and operating procedures of the relevant clearing system.

Each of the Trustee and the IsDB has represented and agreed, that it has not offered and will not offer the Trust Certificates to be issued under the Programme to any person on AIX unless such offer is made only to or directed to only Accredited Investors (as defined in section 1.1.2(6)(a) of MAR Rules).

FINAL TERMS

MIFID II PRODUCT GOVERNANCE – Solely for the purposes of each manufacturer’s product approval process, the target market assessment in respect of the Trust Certificates has led to the conclusion that: (i) the target market for the Trust Certificates is eligible counterparties and professional clients only, each as defined in Directive 2014/65/EU (as amended, **MiFID II**); and (ii) all channels for distribution of the Trust Certificates to eligible counterparties and professional clients are appropriate. 
